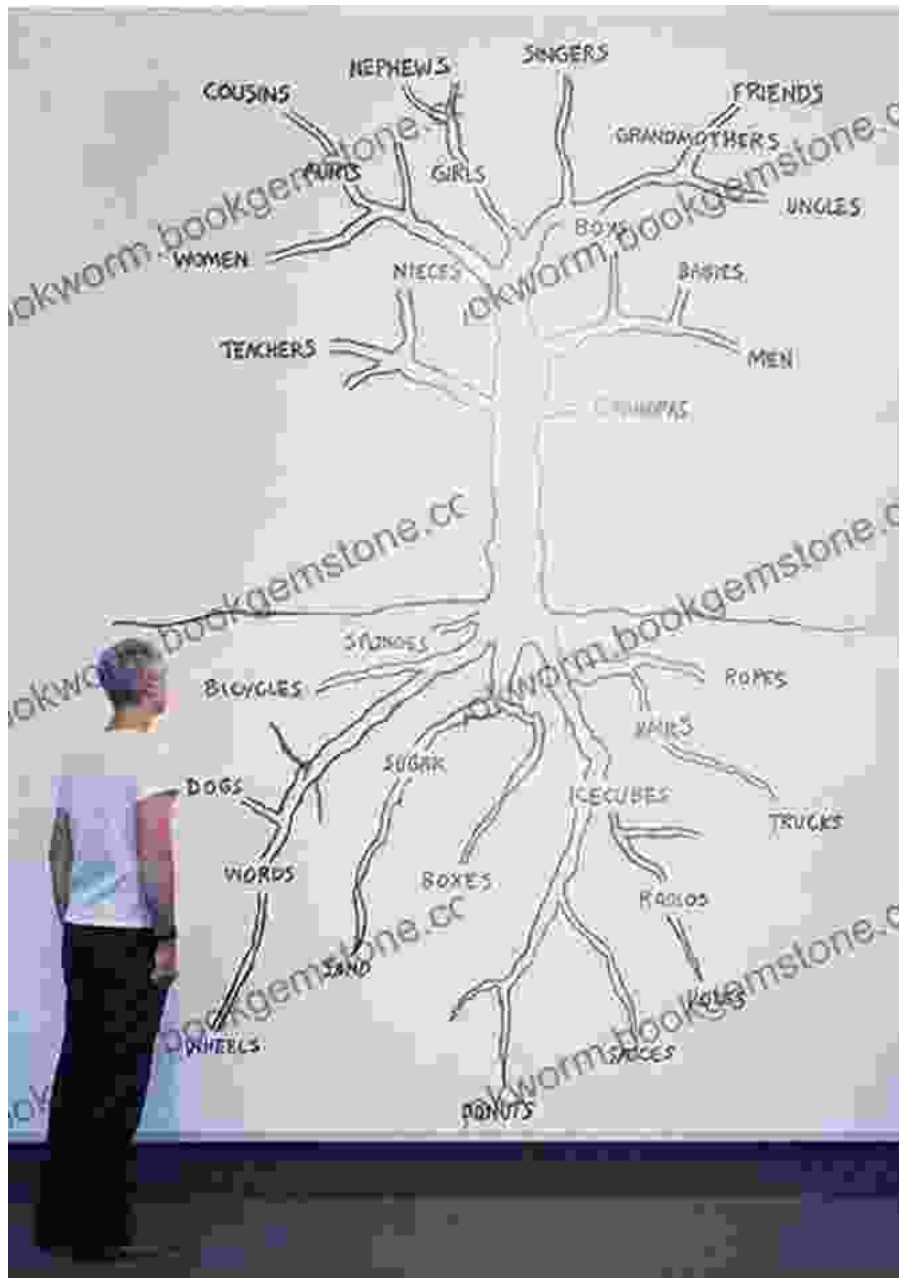


A serene path winding through the desert landscape at Arboretum David Byrne.

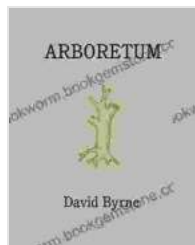

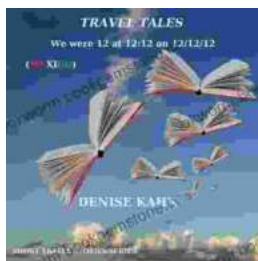

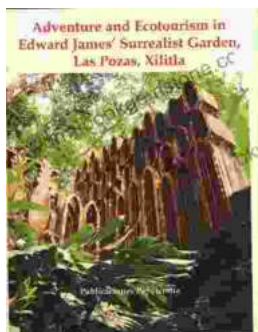
