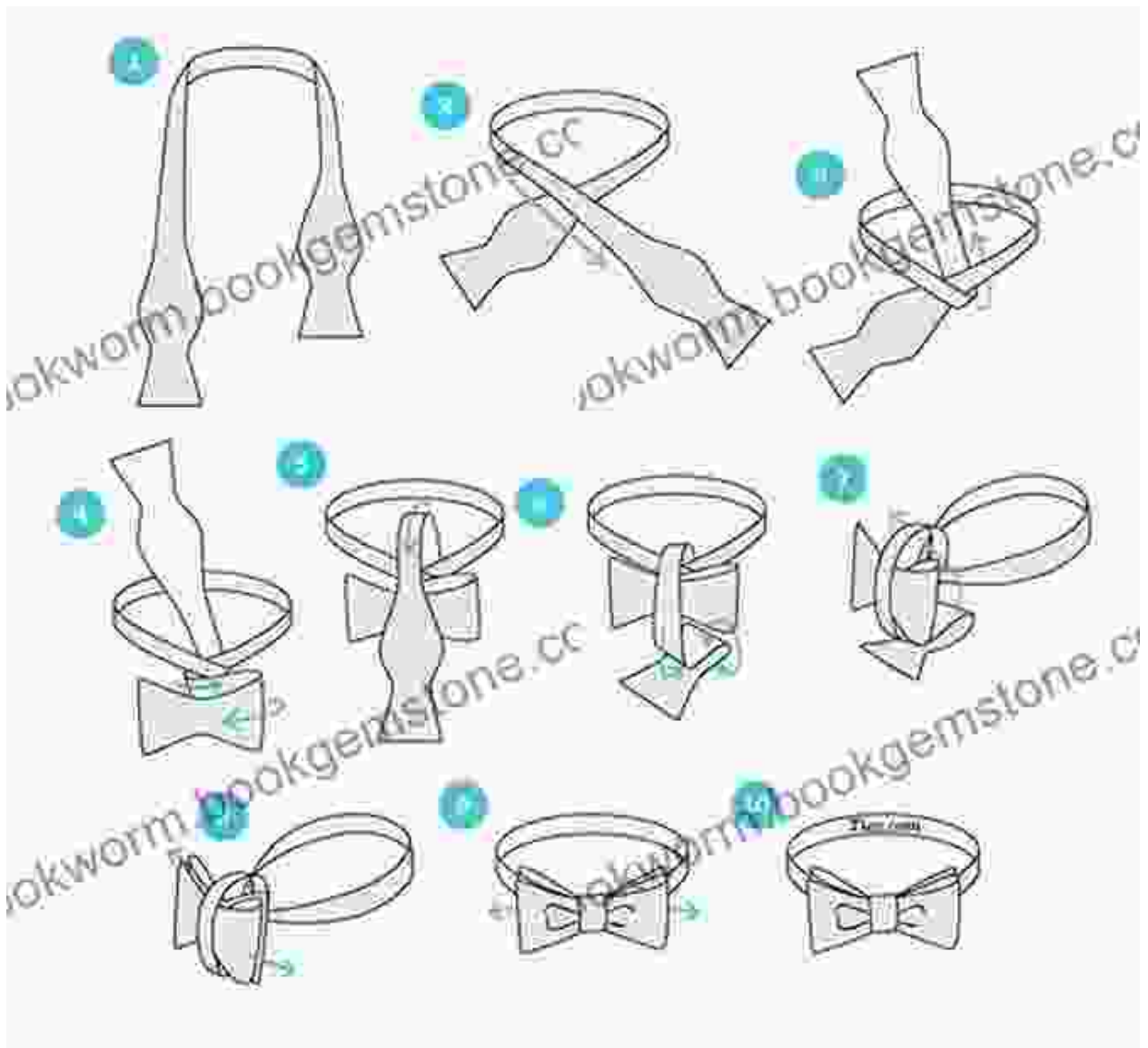

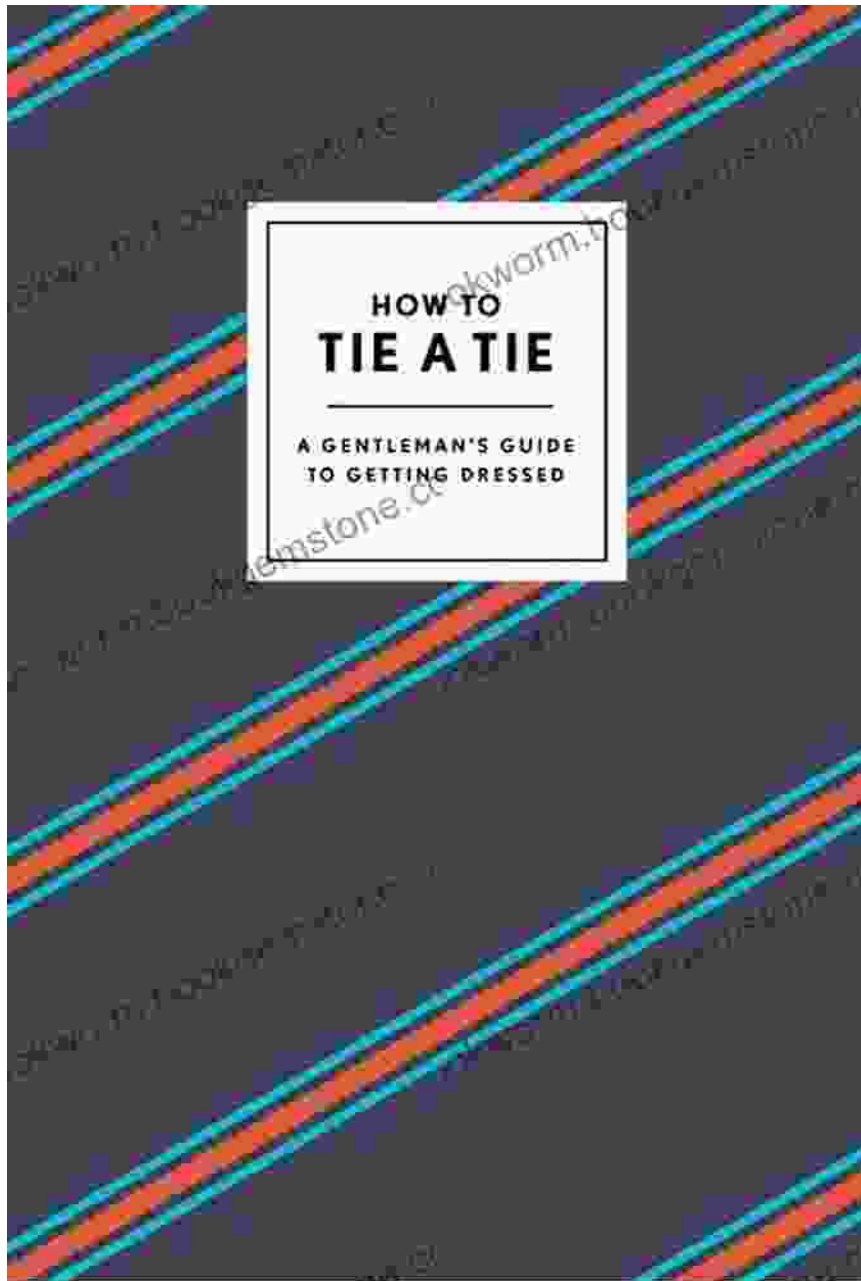


5. Pull both ends of the tie to tighten the knot.

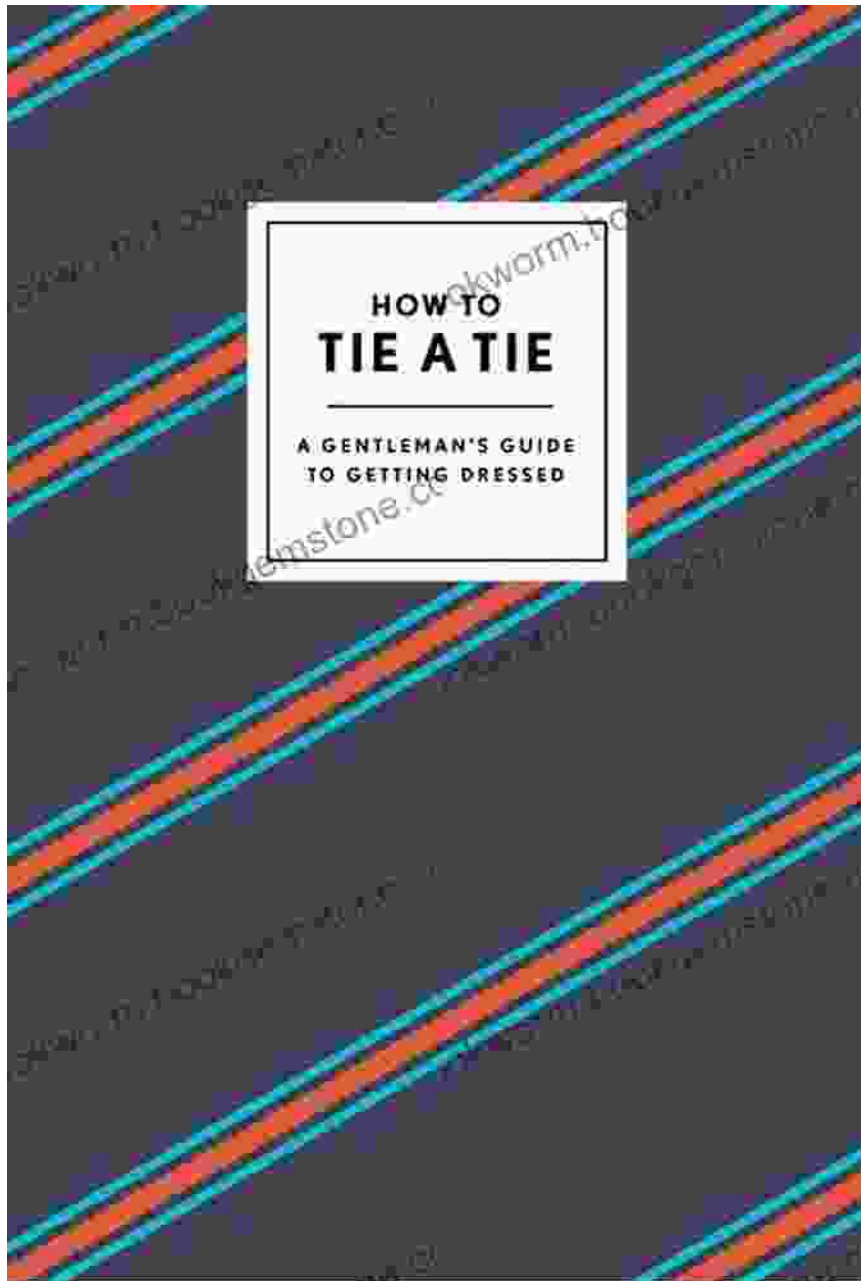
### **Bow Tie**



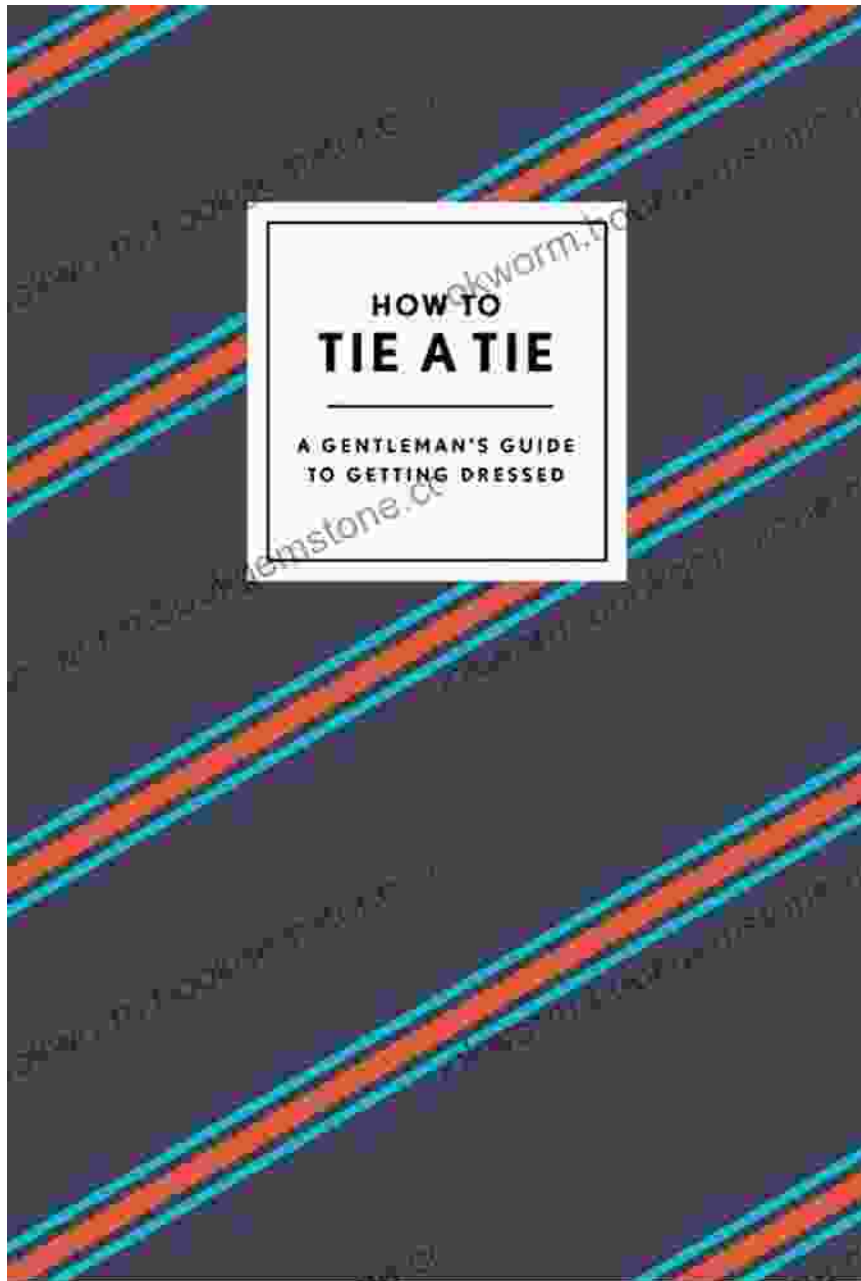
1. Position the bow tie around your neck so that the left side is longer than the right.



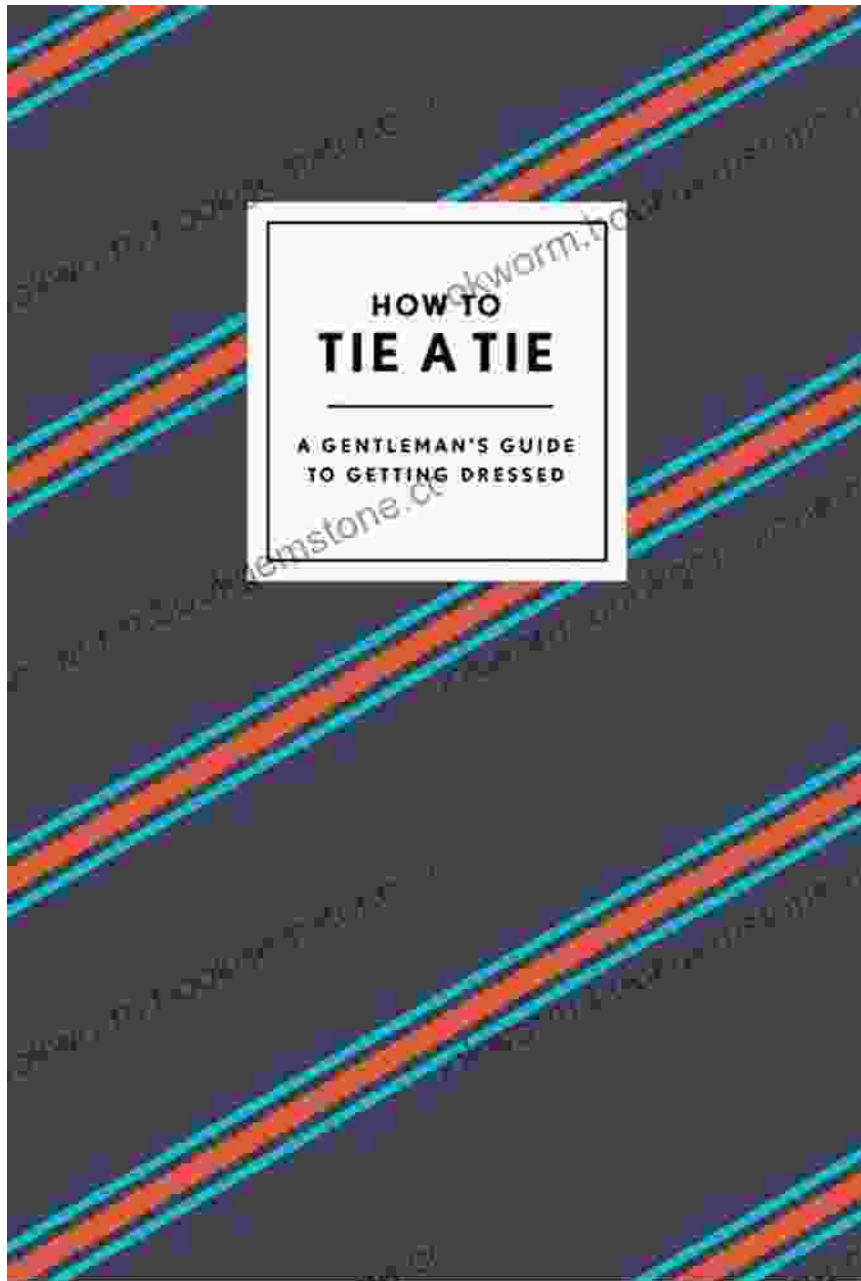
2. Cross the right end over the left end.



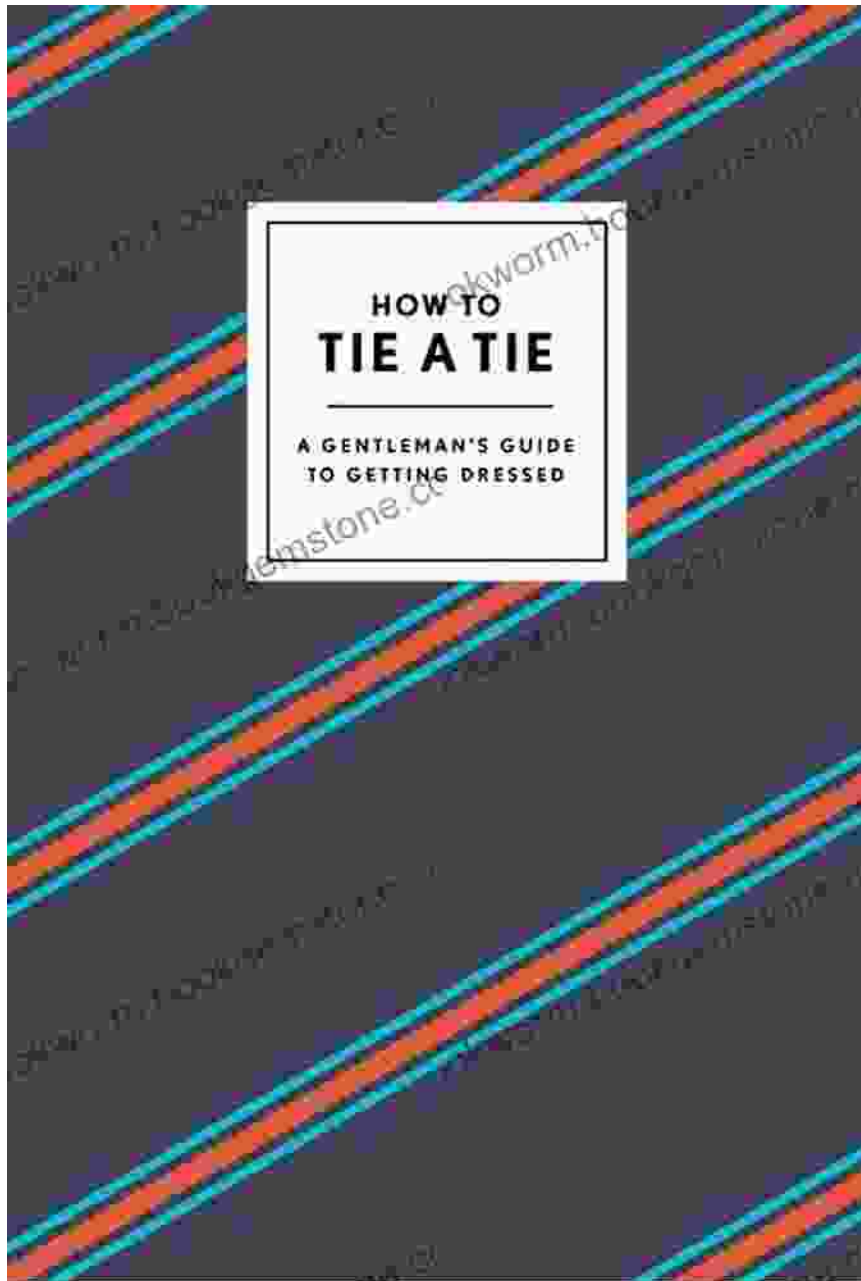
3. Bring the right end up and through the loop from the back.



4. Fold the right end down and across the left end.

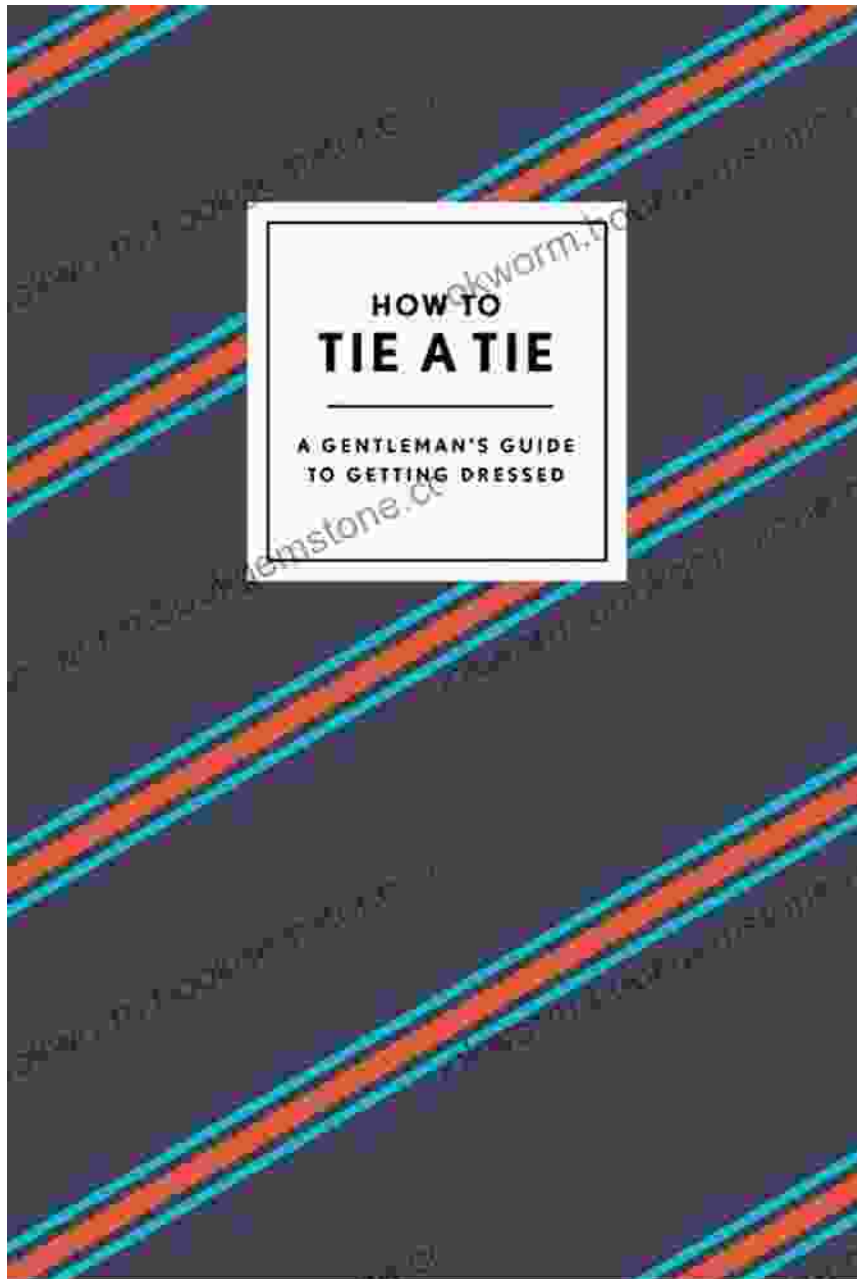


5. Bring the right end up and through the loop from the side.



6. Pull both ends of the tie to tighten the knot.





7. Adjust the bow tie to the desired shape.

#### **4. Finishing Touches**

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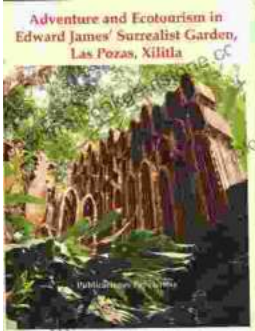
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
