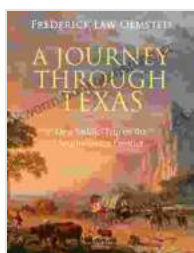

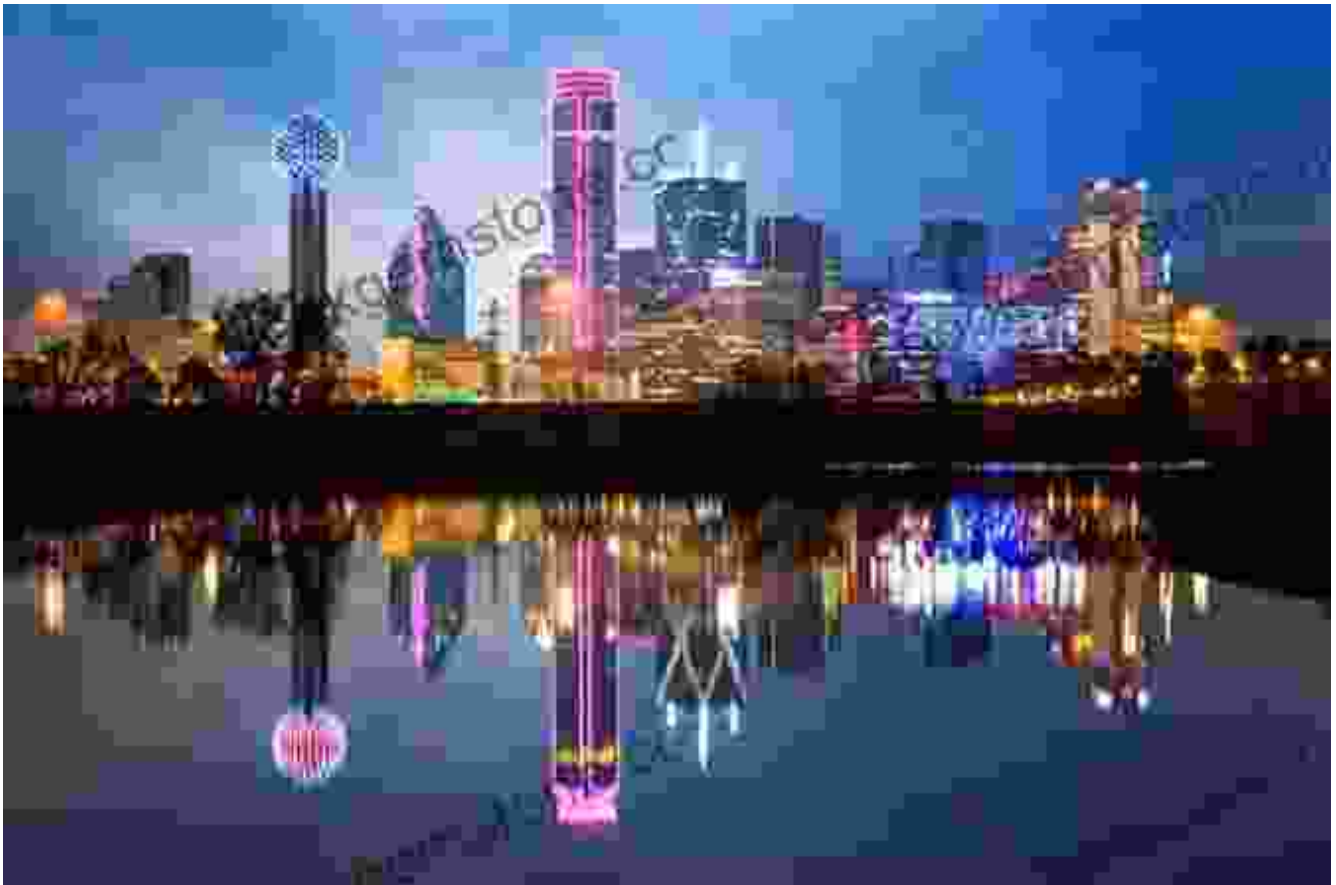

The illuminated skyline of Dallas, Texas

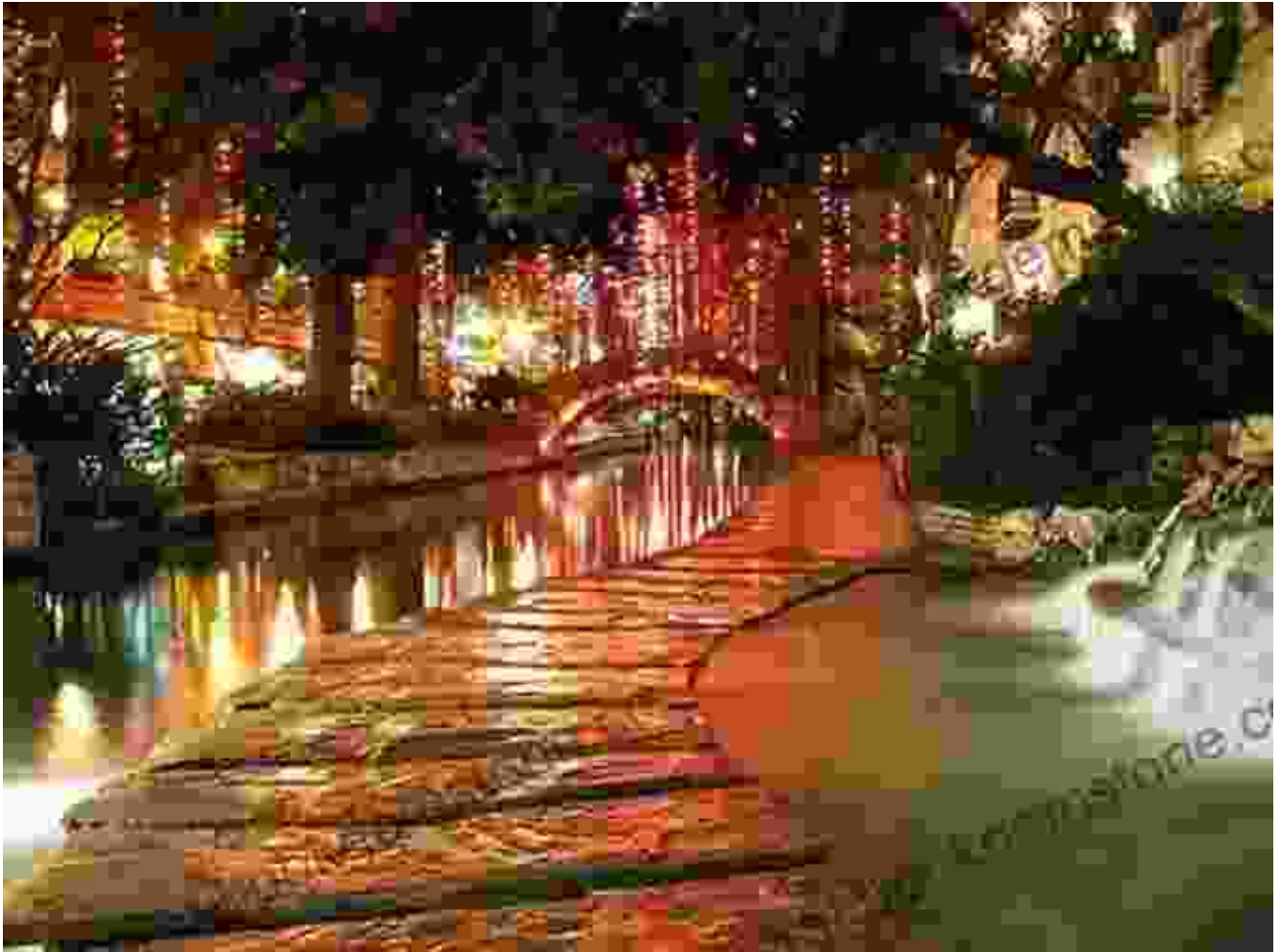

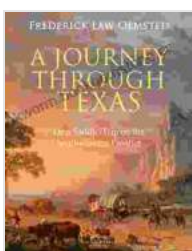

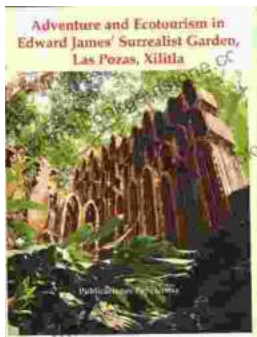
