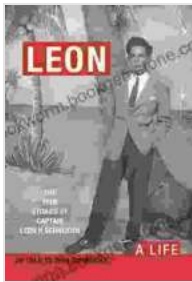


Life: The True Stories of Captain Leon Schneider

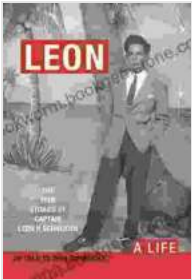

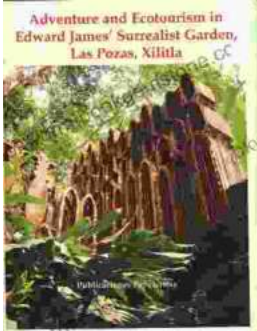
